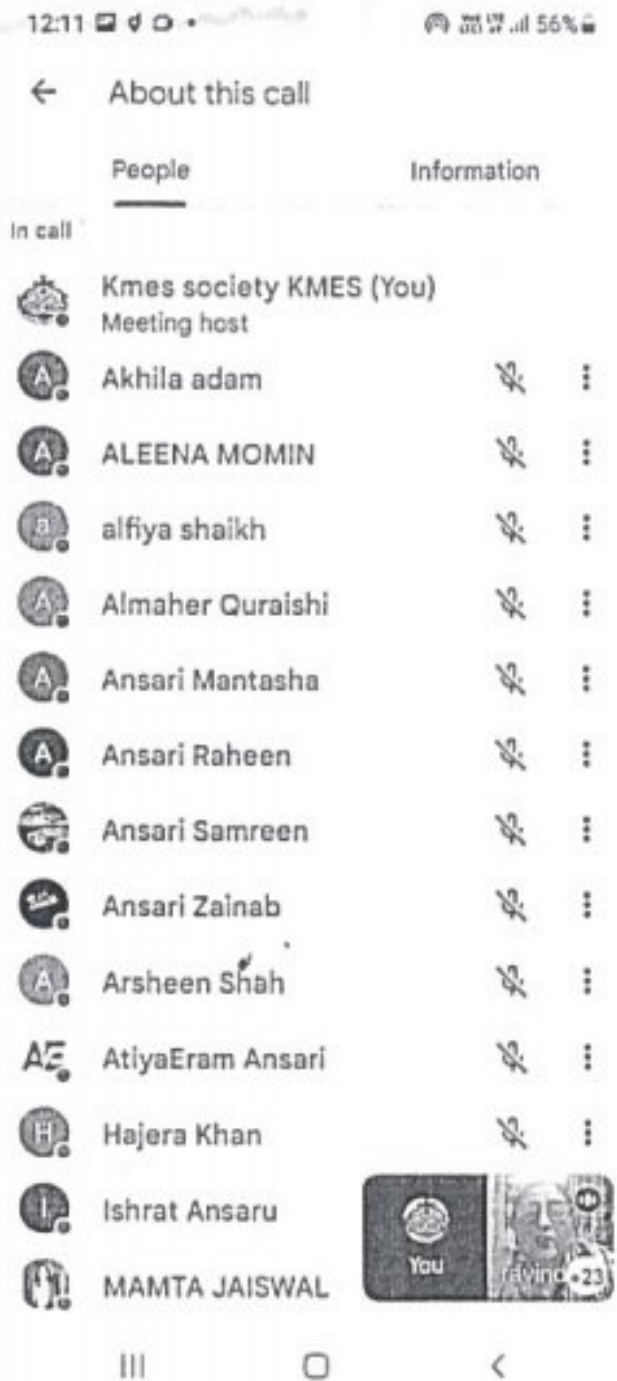
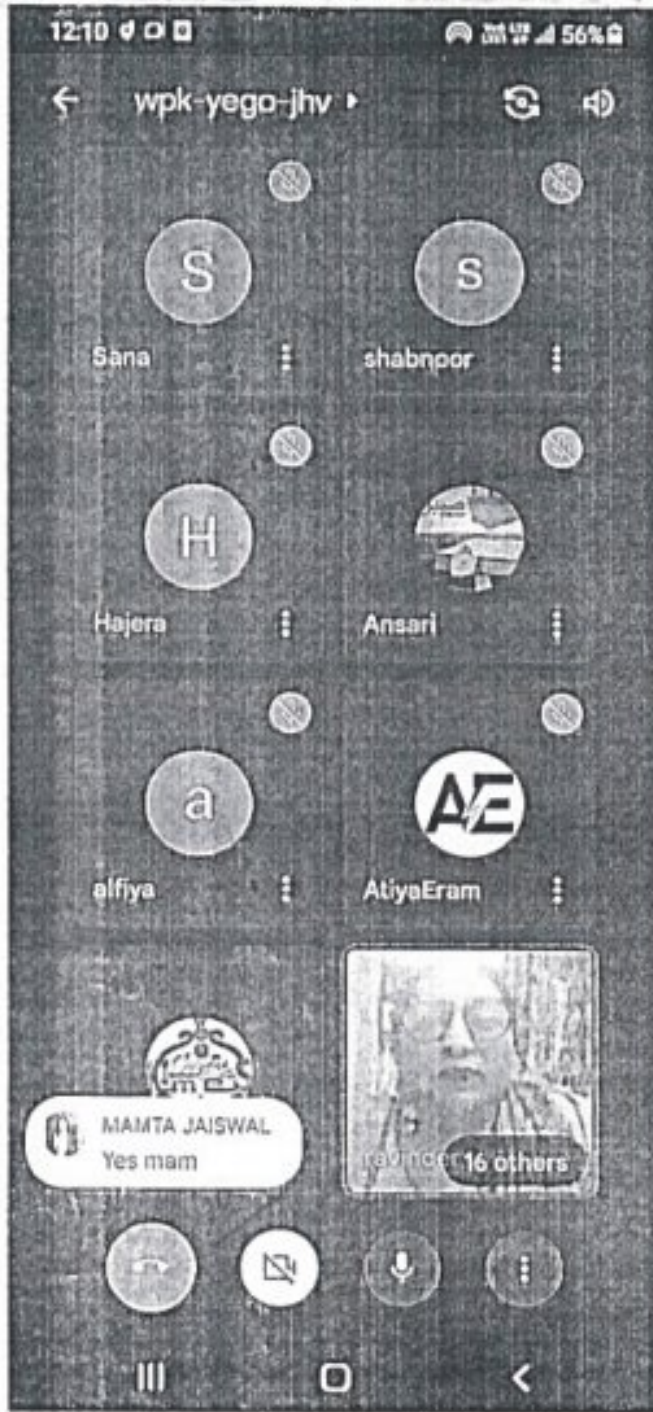

After a number of discussions with different hiring managers and recruiters from all aspects of the employment industry, we came up with the 10 most common job interview questions and answers to help you knock it out of the park.

- 1. Tell me about yourself*
- 2. What is your greatest strength?*
- 3. What is your greatest weakness?*
- 4. Why should we hire you?*
- 5. What's something positive your boss would say about you?*
- 6. What are your salary expectations?*
- 7. Why are you leaving your current role?*
- 8. What interests you about this position?*
- 9. What are your future goals?*
- 10. Describe a difficult work situation on how you overcame it.*

1. TELL ME ABOUT YOURSELF.

Most job interview questions are open-ended, and the interviewer is often as interested in how you answer over the specific details of the answer.

In the case of this common question, they're looking to understand what you know and what you've done, particularly as it relates to the job you're interviewing for. They're not looking for your full life story.

HOW TO ANSWER:

Briefly share details about how you got to where you are today. Tie in those experiences to the skills you have that are relevant to the position.


Keep it brief, but be prepared with some more information if the interviewer asks you to elaborate on anything that you mentioned.

EXAMPLE ANSWERS:

- *“During my time with Google, I branched out from copywriting and grew more passionate about Social Media.”*

“I developed most of my paid ad and social copywriting experience through live training events where I ended up testing at the top of my class...”

2. WHAT IS YOUR GREATEST STRENGTH?

This is one of those questions that has become a bit of a cliché, but it still may come up in your interview. The interviewer is testing your confidence and looking to see what qualifies you for the role.

HOW TO ANSWER:

It's important to discuss what qualifies you for the position, and what may set you apart from other candidates.

Study the job description carefully prior to an interview, and make sure that you can talk about the “Must Have” or “Required” skills as part of this strengths conversation.

EXAMPLE ANSWERS:

- “As an HR Specialist over the last 3 years, I would say employee care is by far my greatest strength. My passion and dedication to the industry have led me to effectively resolve employee issues and understand them at a deeper level...”*
- “One of my greatest strengths is my attention to detail. In my data entry work, I've always been careful to avoid errors by double-checking everything so that I don't submit anything incorrect.”*

3. WHAT IS YOUR GREATEST WEAKNESS?

The typical follow-up question to your greatest strength is your biggest weakness. With this question, the interviewer is looking to see if you're open to criticism and have a desire to improve.

HOW TO ANSWER:


Stay away from personal qualities and concentrate on professional traits. Think about skills that you've been trying to improve, or that you've made progress with recently.

Regardless of your weakness, let the interviewer know you're currently working on turning the negative (weakness) into a positive.

Everyone has flaws, and saying you don't will likely lead to rejection.

EXAMPLE ANSWERS:

- *“My greatest weakness is being too direct and outspoken at times in the workplace. I'll often get caught up in the moment and say whatever comes to mind without processing the information first. I've been working on correcting this by analyzing all the details of a conversation before speaking up...”*
- *“My greatest weakness has been keeping everyone up to date with project status updates when I'm fully engrossed in the detail work of a project. I've been trying to be more proactive with sending out updates to the team by making a habit of taking some time at the end of the day to go over all my active projects and send out any relevant updates.”*

4. WHY SHOULD WE HIRE YOU?

The answer, "Because I really need a job," might come to mind but it might be a good idea to back off on that response. What the interviewer is looking for here is what sets you apart from others.

They want you to differentiate and sell yourself!

HOW TO ANSWER:

Create a short, detailed sales pitch explaining why you deserve the job. Emphasize what makes you unique to build confidence in the interviewer's decision to hire you.

EXAMPLE ANSWERS:

- "Your company provides similar services to my background so I'll have an initial understanding of the role. With that being said, I believe that my familiarity with the industry and passion for this type of work would make me a good fit for this position..."*
- "I think that my combination of sales and customer service experience, along with my art background, means that I'll be able to understand what your customers are looking for."*

5. WHAT'S SOMETHING POSITIVE YOUR BOSS WOULD SAY ABOUT YOU?

This is one of those behavioral interview questions which can be tricky to understand exactly what they're looking for.

Just saying that your boss approves of your work isn't enough. The interviewer is looking to see what kind of relationships you've built with the management team, and get an impression about how you may fit in with their team.


HOW TO ANSWER:


This is a great time to brag about yourself with someone else's words. Start with "My boss has told me that..." so that it's clear you understand the question.

Stay humble and refrain from sounding arrogant.

EXAMPLE ANSWERS:

- *"My boss has mentioned that my attention to detail and thoroughness can't be matched."*
- *"She said the last campaign we ran together produced amazing results because of my effort and ability to thoroughly run it from start to finish..."*
- *"My boss mentioned that she's gotten a lot of compliments about my customer service from customers."*

6. WHAT ARE YOUR SALARY EXPECTATIONS?

Of all the job interview questions that make people nervous, this may be the most nerve-wracking. The interviewer is looking to see what you're currently making and if it's within their budget.

HOW TO ANSWER:

It seems like a simple question, but your answer can make or break a job offer.

It's in your best interest that the employer mentions a pay range first. Unfortunately, that's not how it always works.

Prepare for this question by doing some research about salaries. Keep a number in mind by understanding the local going rates and your bottom line. What pay rate would you accept and walk away from?

Note: In some states it is illegal for an employer to ask about your current salary.

EXAMPLE ANSWERS:

- “What kind of rate are you offering for someone with my type of background?”*
- “As I understand it, the salary range is around 30000\-, is that about right?”*

7. WHY ARE YOU LEAVING (OR HAVE LEFT) YOUR JOB?

This is another one of those behavioral interview questions.

The specific reasons for your leaving are often less important to the interviewer than how you conduct yourself when discussing it.

The interviewer is often looking to see if you speak ill of your former employer and/or left on good terms.

HOW TO ANSWER:


When asked about why you are moving on, state your reason in a positive manner rather than being directly critical or accusatory.

Focus on what you'll get out of the change in employment. If you are currently employed, you can explain that your career goals don't line up with the company's direction, and if you were recently let go, give them a brief overview about why, without ever bashing your previous employer.

EXAMPLE ANSWERS:

- *"My current employer's vision has changed over the past few years and no longer lines up with mine."*
- *"After 4 years with the organization, I've made the decision to look for a company where I can utilize my skills and share similar values..."*

8. WHY DO YOU WANT THIS JOB?

Don't be tempted (Urge to do something) to answer "Because I need a job!". The interviewer is looking to see if you'll be a good fit with the company, and if you have specific goals for your career.


HOW TO ANSWERS:


Be specific about why you're a great fit for the role.

Mention aspects of the company that appeal to you along with your short and long term goals. Reiterate (Say something again for emphasis or clarity) your commitment to the hiring manager prior to finishing the interview.

EXAMPLE ANSWER:

- "I know the company's mission and growth-oriented mindset are in line with my values. Both get me excited about work and what the future holds which is why I would love to be part of the team...."*

9. WHAT ARE YOUR FUTURE GOALS?

This interview question, like the previous one, is intended (Planned) to see if you'll be a good long-term fit with the company.

The interviewer is looking for commitment and motivation.


HOW TO ANSWER:

Focus on your career goals that align with the company. Demonstrate your understanding of the company's mission, and how you can find your place there.

If there is a clear promotion path available that you're interested in, feel free to mention it.

EXAMPLE ANSWERS:

- *“Eventually I'd like to make my way into a project management position. I'm already familiar with many of the aspects of the work, so I'd like to improve my knowledge in the areas I'm less familiar with so that I can oversee an entire project.”*
- *“I enjoy working with people and helping to resolve conflicts, so I can see myself moving up in HR eventually.”*

10. DESCRIBE A DIFFICULT WORK SITUATION & HOW YOU OVERCAME IT.

This is another typical interview question. The interviewer is looking for some insight about how you problem-solve and how you handle a challenge.

HOW TO ANSWER:


Share how you've handled a tough situation with big implications.

Break it down into parts, giving a detailed overview on how it was fixed, especially your role in solving the issue. Make sure to provide measurable metrics and results for the interviewer.

EXAMPLE ANSWER:

- “We were down 5 staff members prior to a charity event we organized for our client who generates roughly 75% of our annual business. They expect a flawless evening every time we put the event on so missing 5 key staff members who had prominent roles was crucial. I ran through all options immediately after receiving the news and began coming up with another game plan. (Talk about what you did and how you did it). The evening went without a hitch (Move) and the client continued doing business with us the following year...”*

SKILLS OF INTERVIEW
PRESENTED BY : PROF. HEENA KHAN

SKILLS OF INTERVIEW:-

Interview skills are skills or actions that allow a person to be more effective throughout the interview process for a new position. Not all interview skills are conventional; rather, many interview skills help candidates prepare for the interview and guide them as they participate in job interviews. Job interviews requires in-depth preparation as well as the ability to feel comfortable and confident when discussing your skills, experience and qualifications with interviewer.



INTRODUCTION:-


An interview is essentially a structured conversation where one participant asks questions, and the other provides answers. In common parlance, the word "interview" refers to a one-on-one conversation between an interviewer and an interviewee.

The following are a few of the most important interview skills that can support the interview process and help set you apart from other candidates:

1. RESEARCH:-


Before you go into an interview, it's important to spend time researching both the company and the position you're applying for. There are several ways you can research an organization, including by:

- a) Reviewing their website, especially the "About" page
- b) Googling the company name and reading any press releases or other information available at the company's social media platforms.
- c) Talking to employees of the company, if possible researching job platforms that provide feedback from current and previous employees about the company.



DEFINITION:-

A formal meeting in which one or more persons question, consult, or evaluate another person.



- d) You should also take time to obtain as much information as possible about the job you are interviewing for. Thoroughly review the job listing, look on the company website for the job listing if available to see if additional details are included and look up current employees who hold the same or similar positions. You can also research the job title in general to get a more broad idea of what's expected and typical duties in that position. The more you know about the position, the better prepared you'll be when going into the interview.

2. PREPARATION:-

should avoid going into an interview unprepared. Set aside at least an hour to prepare the day before or on the day of the interview. Here are a few actions to take when preparing:

- Re-read the job description and determine the most relevant responsibilities and requirements for the position.
- Come up with several specific answers to potential questions related to the position you're applying for and the duties that will be expected of you.
- Make a list of the essential aspects of the job so you have it on hand when answering and asking questions during the job interview.
- Go over your cover letter and resume you provided to the company to ensure you remember how you initially presented yourself.



4. PROFESSIONALISM:-

There are several aspects that go into professionalism, and all of them are important when attending a job interview. To begin, ensure your attire is professional and tasteful and is neatly pressed and clean. Avoid wearing clothes that are too casual, too large or small, too revealing or too flamboyant. Aim for an outfit with neutral colors that match and are not distracting or offensive. If you are unsure of the dress code requirements for the interview, dress in a more formal way to avoid dressing too casually.

When arriving at the interview location, use professional language when checking in and greeting the interviewer. Be polite to everyone you come into contact with, including other employees and receptionists. The more polite and professional you are in your actions and words, the more kind and pleasant you can come off to employers.



several minutes or even hours researching possible interview questions related to the position you're applying for and the industry the company is part of.

- Look up less specific interview questions that aren't directly related to the job, but may still be asked. For example, practice a few behavioral and situational interview questions.
- Practice answering interview questions with a friend or family member so you feel comfortable when answering questions during the actual interview.
- Prepare several specific examples from your previous job experience, including milestones, challenges and successes. These will support your interview answers and help strengthen your responses.
- Look over your notes you prepared on the company during the research process to ensure the information is fresh in your mind when going into the interview.

5. COMMUNICATION:-

Good communication skills are crucial during the job interview process. This includes written, verbal and nonverbal communication skills. A few key tips to keep in mind when communicating with others during an interview include:

- Address the interview by name and ensure you pronounce the name or names correctly.
- Begin the interview with appropriate small talk.
- It's best to come prepared with a few conversation starters that are professional and conducive to an interview setting.
- Match your communication style to the interviewer. For example, if the interviewer is communicating in a professional way, try to match your tone to theirs. If they are more upbeat and offer jokes here and there, don't be afraid to do the same as long as they're appropriate.



3. PUNCTUALITY:-

On the day of the interview, make sure you arrive at least 15 minutes before the scheduled interview time. Punctuality is an important trait that interviewer and employers value and gives them an idea of how punctual you will be on a daily basis if you are hired for the position.

To ensure you arrive on time, consider planning out your outfit the night before and ironing it so that it's ready the next day. You should also back your purse or briefcase the night before and ensure you have a copy of your resume and cover letter on hand. Set an alarm and make sure you have reliable transportation for the time of the interview.



- Avoid interrupting the person you are interviewing with when they are speaking.
- Don't use jargon or abbreviated language when speaking with the interviewer.
- Try to avoid using speech fillers like "um" and "like."
- Copy the interviewer's body language. For example, if they are sitting in an upright position with their hands on the table, do the same.
- Be aware of your own body language to ensure you are presenting yourself in a professional and positive way.

6. LISTENING:-

Listening skills are another important component of a successful interview experience. It's easy to listen to a person speak, and while so to think to yourself how you will respond. While this may seem wise, it can also prevent you from actually hearing what the other person is saying. Listen attentively when the interviewer is speaking, paraphrase what they said either in your mind or out loud when appropriate and use nonverbal cues such as nodding, making eye contact and leaning in when the other person is talking.

You should also ask for clarification if you misunderstand something that was said to ensure communication is effective. Avoid quickly changing the subject and take note of any nonverbal cues the interviewer is giving you, such as facial expressions and tone of voice, to further understand what's being said.





9. SHOWING INTEREST:-

It's important to convey your genuine interest in the position during a job interview. If you give off a sense of disinterest or apathy, the interviewer may think you don't truly want the position or care about the outcome of the interview. Work to show earnest interest in the organization and position and a passion for your work and your abilities to complete the duties of the job.

7. ASK QUESTIONS:-

Interviewers often ask candidates if they have any questions during or after the interview. Interviewers look for candidates who ask genuine questions to help them gain a better understanding of the company and the role. Arrive at the interview prepared with a few questions to ask the interviewer that demonstrates a genuine interest in the opportunity and provides a chance to further discuss elements of the job that may not have been covered.


10. FOLLOW-UP:-




Following up soon after an interview is considered crucial by many recruiters and hiring managers. A simple thank-you card or thank-you email can go a long way to show the interviewer you are genuinely interested in the position and are grateful for their time. Try to send a follow-up email or note the same day as the interview or the next day at the latest.

8. CONFIDENCE:-

Confidence has a significant impact on how you are perceived by interviewers. Arrive at the interview ready to discuss your experience, accomplishments and abilities in a confident way that conveys your own belief in yourself to perform the duties of the position you applied for. Work to exude a balanced and kind sense of confidence rather than simply boasting about your qualifications.

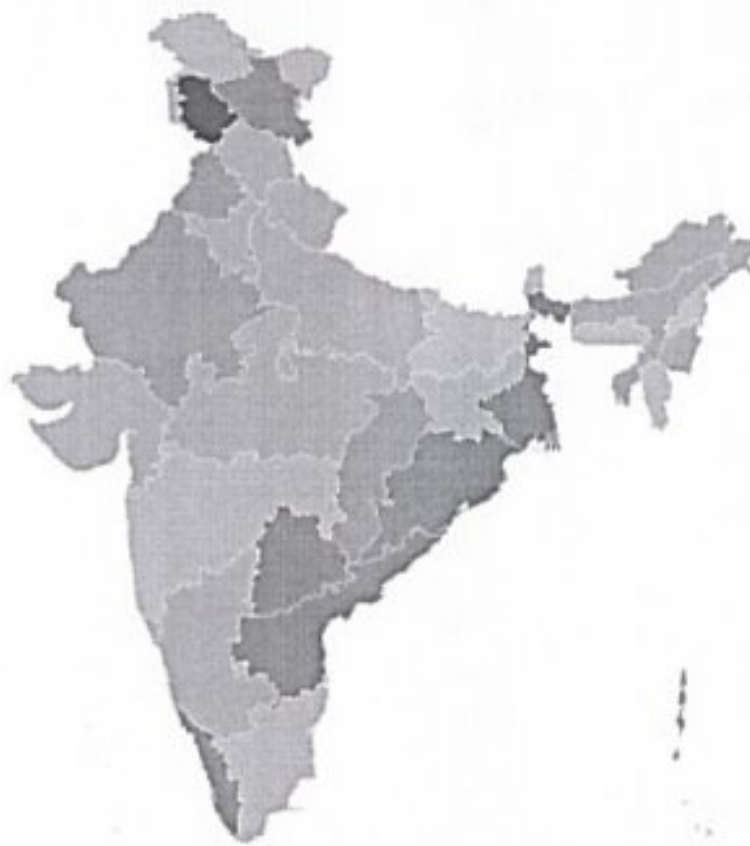

List of current Indian chief ministers

In the Republic of India, a chief minister is the head of government of each of the twenty-eight states and three of the eight union territories. According to the Constitution of India, at the state-level, the governor is *de jure* head, but *de facto* executive authority rests with the chief minister. Following elections to the state legislative assembly, the governor usually invites the party (or coalition) with a majority of seats to form the state government. The governor appoints the chief minister, whose council of ministers are collectively responsible to the assembly. Given they have the assembly's confidence, the chief minister's term is usually for a maximum of five years; there are no limits to the number of terms they can serve.^[1]

As of February 2022, the office of the chief minister of Jammu and Kashmir is vacant. Of the thirty incumbents, one is a woman—Mamata Banerjee in West Bengal. Serving since 5 March 2000 (for 21 years, 337 days) ~~Shilpa~~ Naveen Patnaik has the longest incumbency. Mizoram's Zoramthanga (b. 13 July 1944) is the oldest Chief Minister, while Arunachal Pradesh's ~~Pema~~ ~~Khandu~~ (b. 21 August 1979) is the youngest Chief Minister.^[2] Nitish Kumar of Bihar has served for the most terms (7).^[3]

BASICS OF COMMERCE

ORIGIN OF COMMERCE:-

The English-language word commerce has been derived from the Latin word 'COMMERCIIUM', from com ("Together") and 'MERX' ("Merchandise").

WHAT IS COMMERCE:-

Commerce is the business of buying and selling things. It refers to the exchange of goods, services, or something of value between businesses or entities on a large scale. Commerce is the activities and procedures involved in buying and selling things.

DEFINITION OF COMMERCE:-

"Commerce is that part of the business which is concerned with the exchange of goods and services and includes all those activities which directly or indirectly facilitate that exchange."
(According to JAMES STEPHENSON.)

WHO IS THE FATHER OF COMMERCE?

The father of commerce is **POSEIDON** according to Greek mythology. Reason: He is the god of the sea and used it for trading.



IMPORTANT SUBJECTS OF COMMERCE:-

- 1) **ORGANIZATION OF COMMERCE AND MANAGEMENT:-** It is same as business management.
- 2) **ECONOMICS:-** Economics is a social science concerned with the production, distribution, and consumption of goods and services.
- 3) **BOOK-KEEPING AND ACCOUNTANCY:-** Bookkeeping is the recording of financial transactions.
- 4) **SECRETARIAL PRACTICE:-** Secretarial Practice is a subject which deals with Company Law, Other corporate laws and secretarial work.

BASIC CONCEPT OF COMMERCE:-

1) BALANCE SHEET:-

Comprised of the assets, liabilities and owner equity categories, your business' balance sheet reflects everything it owns, including the properties' corresponding values. It also shows any amounts that your business currently owes.

2) PROFIT AND LOSS:-

Made up of the other two categories of your business' general ledger, a P&L totals the income and expenses over a period of time. The figures reflected demonstrate how the business is trading.

3) ASSETS:-

The category refers to the things that are bought and you own.

4) LIABILITIES:-

In contrast to your business' assets, this category refers to what is owed by your business to other parties, or how you paid for your assets.

5) OWNER'S EQUITY:-

Also known as shareholder equity, this category describes the capital introduced and withdrawn by the business owner or shareholders:- It is essentially the balance of what you own, less what you owe (your assets less your liabilities).

06) PLANNING:-

Planning is the process of thinking regarding the activities required to achieve a desired goal.

07) MANAGEMENT:-

An organized way of managing people and things of a business organization is called the Management.

08) ADMINISTRATION:-

The process of administering an organization by a group of people is known as the Administration.

10) LEDGER:-

A ledger is a book or collection of accounts in which account transactions are recorded.

1. THE TRADITIONAL INTERVIEW:-

This is the scenario you'll face most often: You sit down with an interviewer and answer a series of questions designed to help her figure out if you're a great candidate for the job.



WHAT IS INTERVIEW:-

An opportunity to sell your abilities, interest and career objectives. An opportunity to ask questions and learn more about the position and career offered by a particular company. You must prove that you are the most suitable candidate. Interviews usually take place face-to-face and in person but the parties may instead be separated geographically, as in video conferencing and telephonic interview. Interviews almost always involve spoken conversation between two or more parties.

2) THE PHONE INTERVIEW:-

Asked for a phone interview? A call is typically a first-round screening to see if you're a fit to come in for a full interview, so nailing it is key. You'll want to prepare just as you would for an in-person interview, with some key adjustments for the phone format.



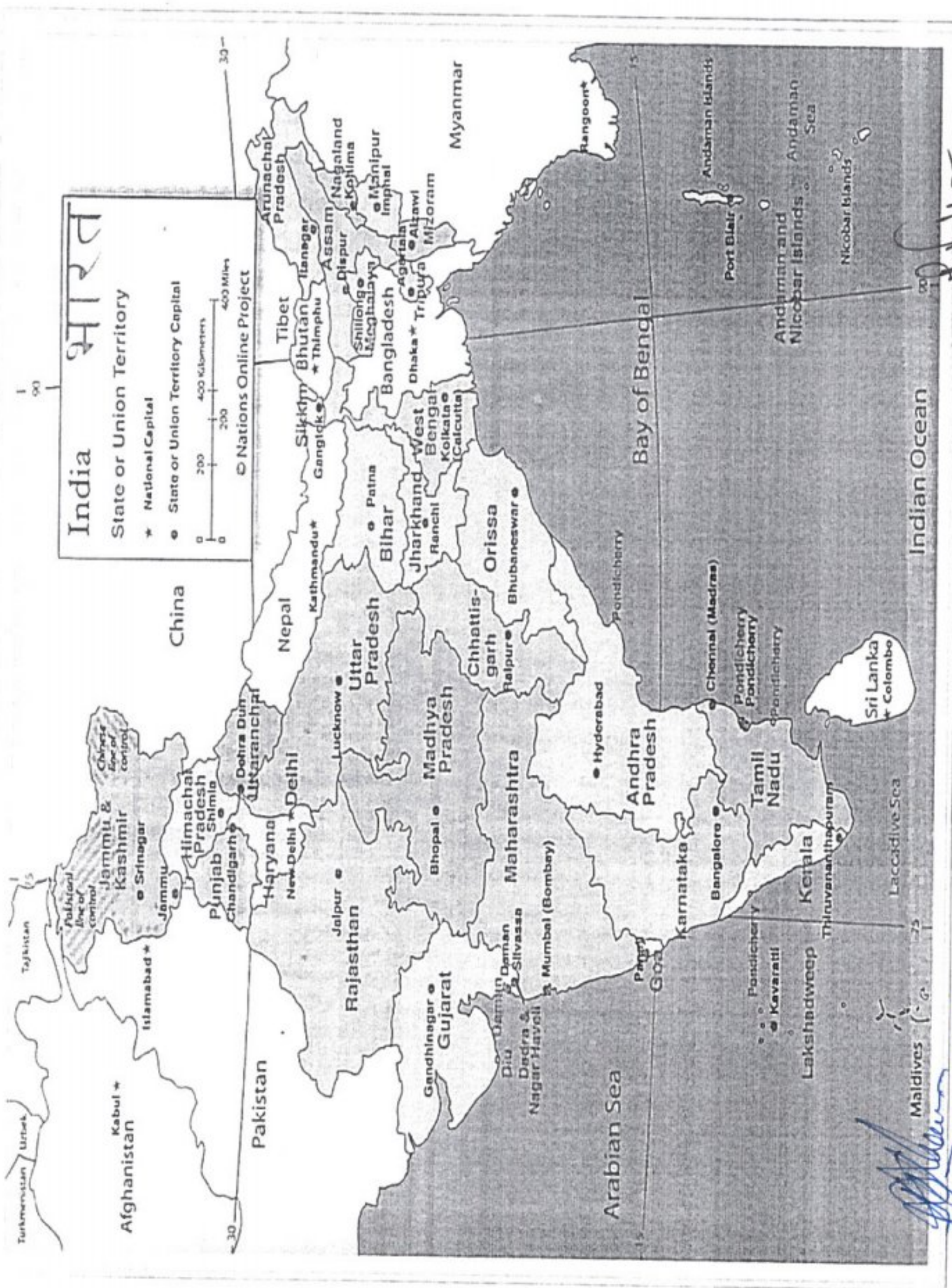

ORIGIN OF ECONOMICS:-

- The word 'economics' comes from two Greek words, 'OIKO' meaning HOME and 'NOMOS' meaning ACCOUNTS. The subject has developed from being about how to keep the family accounts into the wide-ranging subject of today.

WHAT IS ECONOMICS:-

- Economics is a social science concerned with the production, distribution, and consumption of goods and services.

DEFINITION OF ECONOMICS:-

"An inquiry into the nature and causes of the wealth of nations."

(By Adam Smith-Father of Economics)



TYPES OF ECONOMICS:-


- Two major types of economics are MICROECONOMICS, which focuses on the behavior of individual consumers and producers, and MACROECONOMICS, which examine overall economies on a regional, national, or international scale.

LAWS OF ECONOMICS:-

Adam Smith's 3 laws of Economics are:-

- LAW OF DEMAND AND SUPPLY-To meet the demand in a market economy.
- LAW OF SELF INTEREST- Sufficient goods would be produced at the lowest price.
- LAW OF COMPETITION- Better products would be produced at lower prices due to competition.

BASIC CONCEPTS OF ECONOMICS:-

- 1) **NEED:-** Basic requirement of survival.
- 2) **WANTS:-** The manner in which the need is satisfied.
- 3) **SCARCITY:-** The demand for a good or service is greater than the availability of the good or service.

4) **VALUE:-** A thing is worth what people will pay for it.

5) **BUDGET:-** A budget is an estimate of income and expenditure for a future period.

6) **TRADE-OFF:-** In Economics, the term trade-off is often expressed as an opportunity cost, which is the most preferred possible alternative.

7) **SUPPLY:-** Describes the total amount of a specific good or service that is available to consumers.

8) **DEMAND:-** Demand is an economic principle referring to a consumer's desire to purchase goods and services and willingness to pay a price for a specific good or service.

9) **UTILITY:-** The satisfaction received from consuming a good or service.

10) **MARGINALITY:-** People make decisions based on benefits they will receive from trading.

11) **PRICE:-** The amount of money that has to be paid to acquire a given product.

12) **GOODS & SERVICES:-** Consumption of goods and services is assumed to provide utility (satisfaction) to the consumer.


13) **INCENTIVE:-** A rise in the price of any good.


14) **WEALTH:-** In economics it is used to describe all things that have value.

15) **PRODUCTION:-** Is an economic term that describes the inputs used in the production of goods or services to make an economic profit.

17) **TAX:-** Taxes are the most important source of governmental revenue.
